### **1. Definition**

In these terms of business:

Kiwi Auctions Limited is referred to as 'KA'.

The KA representative conducting the auction is referred to as the 'auctioneer'.

### **2. Attribution and Condition of Lots**

We make every effort to ensure the accuracy of any statement as to authorship, attribution, origin, date, age, provenance, and condition of any lot, whether or not. Any statement made orally or in the catalogue is an opinion given after careful consideration and research.

Written condition reports are available upon request for buyers unable to attend viewing in person.

When bidding, you acknowledge that you are fully satisfied as to the attribution and condition of the lot.

### **3. Third Party Liability**

Every person on KA premises before, during or after a sale shall be deemed to be there at their own risk and shall have no claim against KA in respect of any injury they may sustain or any accident which may occur.

### **4. Disputes**

Any dispute not covered in these terms of business will be settled at the sole discretion of KA.

### **5. The Seller**

a. KA sell as agents for the seller (Vendor).

b. KA reserve the right to fix a reserve price for any lot.

c. Payment we aim to pay you no later than 28 working days after the auction.

We do not pay interest on the period between your buyer's payment and your receipt of the payment.

We act as agents and cannot be held responsible if your buyer does not pay. We cannot pay you until we have received cleared funds.

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The highest bidder acknowledged as such by the auctioneer will be the buyer. If any dispute arises, the auctioneer has absolute discretion to settle the matter.

The auctioneer rules the bidding and bids cannot be retracted. The auctioneer reserves the right to refuse any bid.

The successful bidder, whether bidding for himself or for a third party, is entirely responsible for paying for the lots they have bought in accordance with KA terms of business.

The auctioneer reserves the right to bid on behalf of the vendors for any lot and to withdraw, consolidate or divide any lot or lots.

### **7. Registration**

Prospective buyers need to register with us, giving their full name, address, contact telephone number(s) and email address. First time buyers will be required to provide proof of identity (i.e., driving licence/passport), a valid debit or credit card. Upon receipt of the above a buyer number will be issued, which is only valid for the current sale. This card may be used to indicate your bids to the Auctioneer during the sale. If successful, the bidder must ensure that their number can be seen by the Auctioneer and that it is their number that is called out. Should there be any doubts as to price or buyer, please draw the Auctioneer's attention to it immediately.

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You will pay a premium of 15% plus GST on the hammer price of your purchase on each lot.

GST is calculated at the rates that apply on the day of the auction.

### **13. Commission Absentee Bids**

If instructed, KA will execute bids and advise prospective buyers.

Buyers who cannot come to a sale may leave their bid with our staff after viewing or make their bid in advance by telephone or email. Such bids are placed at the buyer's own risk.

Bids must be made at least one hour before the sale starts, and we advise buyers to make bids within one hour of the close of the view day.

When making bids, buyers must provide:

- Their maximum bid amount – excluding commission which will be added to the invoice afterwards.

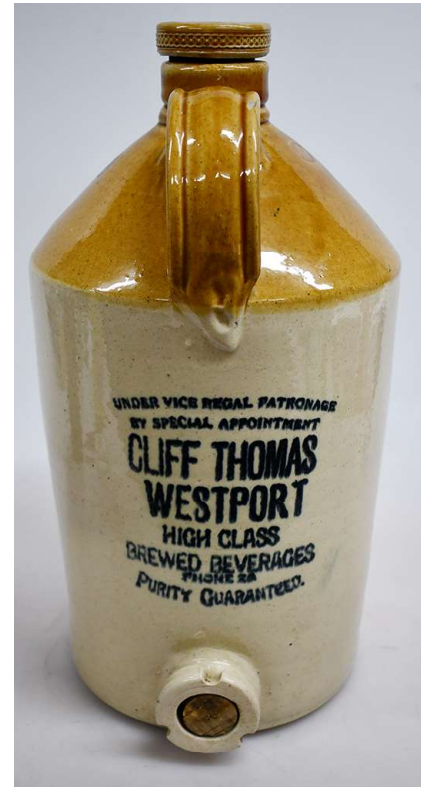

A very Early Rare printed tin sign for "The Union Fire & Marine of New Zealand, with images of a Maori Gent & Kiwi Bird.

Size is 252mm x 176mm, condition is Very Good for the age, has a small wrinkle to bottom left and light wear/paint loss to bottom left and top right corners, light wear, minor marks, Very Good 8.5/10

From our research the age of the sign is likely made between 1877 & 1891, making it one of New Zealand earliest advertising signs.

The Union Fire and Marine Insurance Company of New Zealand was established and issued its prospectus in Christchurch in July 1877, with its head office located on Hereford Street. It operated as a colonial enterprise with a capital of £2,000,000 before being acquired by the Alliance Assurance Co in 1891 and officially wound up.

The sign was made by Wells & Hope Co. Established in 1845 and was located in Philadelphia, PA. The Wells and Hope Company was known for their production of lithographs specialized in metal signs, glass, and mirror advertisements. Among these signs were large and small, embossed, curved and flat, full colour as well as black, gold, and silver "shield signs". Wells and Hope Co. was active up until the early 1890s era and eventually closed in 1907.

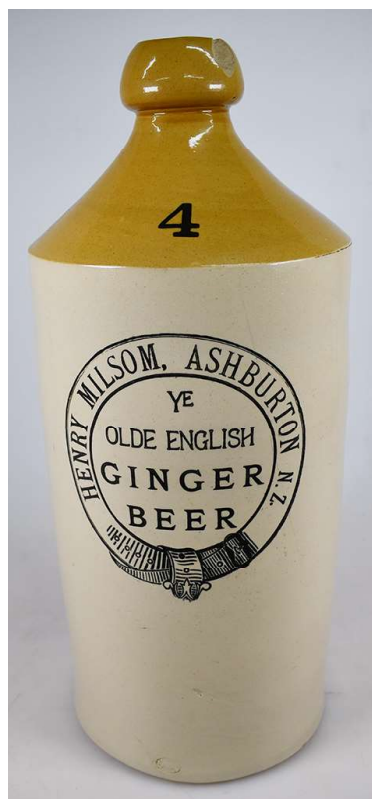

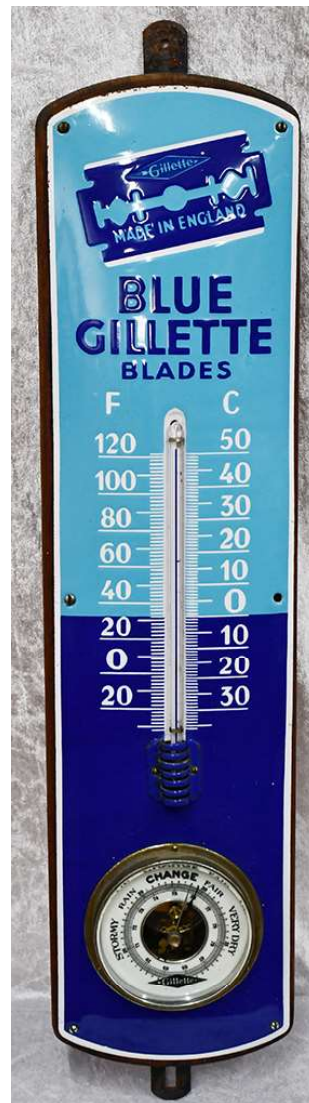
